

# How to use your MakoRx card and benefits:

## Step 1: Your Card and Member information:



- ✓ You and any enrolled dependents should have received this card in your mail and via email.
- ✓ You have pharmacy coverage through your major medical insurance as well, this card is for the \$0 cost medications

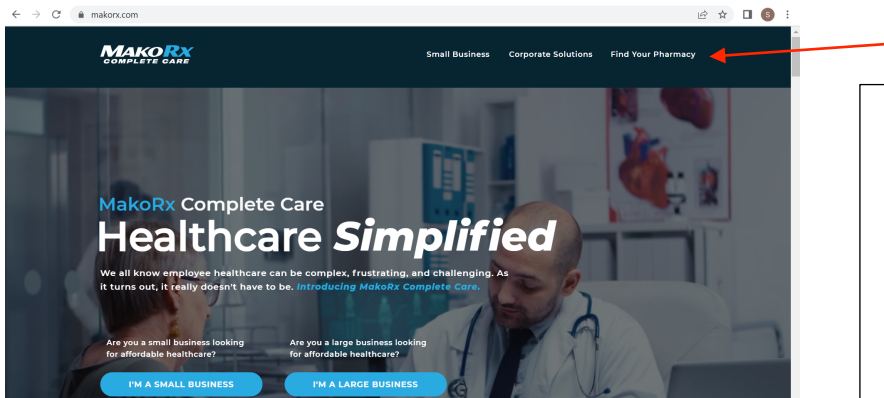
## Step 2: Find your medications

Go to [www.makorx.com](http://www.makorx.com) (scroll down to the bottom of the page for the list) to determine if you're taking medications that are on our 300+ \$0 cost list. If they're not, call our customer service number or speak to your doctor about alternatives that are covered at \$0



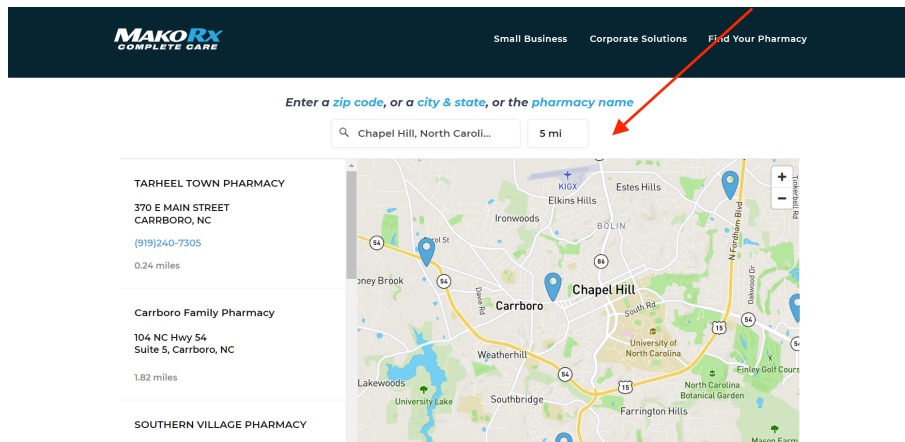
## Step 3: Find your Pharmacy

Go to [www.makorx.com](http://www.makorx.com) and select the “Find Your Pharmacy” tab at the top of the page



- ✓ The medications are \$0 at participating pharmacies
- ✓ Most pharmacies offer free home or hotel delivery, make sure to ask!

**\*Please note: CVS, Walgreens and Walmart do not participate in our \$0 prescription program.**

### Important Reminders:

- ✓ You can enroll any dependents or family members you'd like in the RoadieDocRx Family Plan. The cost of the family plan regardless of how many dependents you enroll is only \$55 per month total.
- ✓ For customer service call us at (855) 562-5679 and a team member will be happy to help.
- ✓ MakoRx provides access to zero-cost medications and is the administrator for RoadieDocRX.
- ✓ First Stop Health is your third-party telemedicine provider.
- ✓ Before calling First Stop for your first telemedicine visit:
  1. Pick your pharmacy
  2. Have your 300+ \$0 cost list handy. The First Stop Health doctors will not know the details of your prescription coverage. If your doctor is writing you a prescription, ask them to review the list on MakoRx.com to choose a \$0 medication if possible.
